An Act to Amend an Ordinance "To establish a Ferry at Wellington, on the River Murray."

[Assented to, 1st September, 1859.]

THEREAS by an Act, No. 22 of 1854, to amend an Ordinance Preamble. "To establish a Ferry at Wellington, on the River Murray," it was amongst other things enacted, that the several tolls, mentioned in the Schedule to such Act, should be payable in lieu of those specified in the Ordinance No. 4 of 1848, and be paid by persons crossing the said Ferry: And whereas it is expedient to substitute other tolls for the said tolls so made payable—Be it therefore Enacted by the Governor-in-Chief of the Province of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly of the said Province in this present Parliament assembled, as follows:-

1. The several tolls mentioned and set forth in the Schedule Tolls in Schedule to hereunto annexed shall be payable and paid by persons using the for tolls imposed by said Ferry, in the place of the tolls mentioned in the said Act.

2. The care, control, and management of the said Ferry shall be Management of Ferry. vested in the persons for the time being having the care, control, and management of the main roads of the said Province.

3. This Act shall take effect from the passing thereof.
