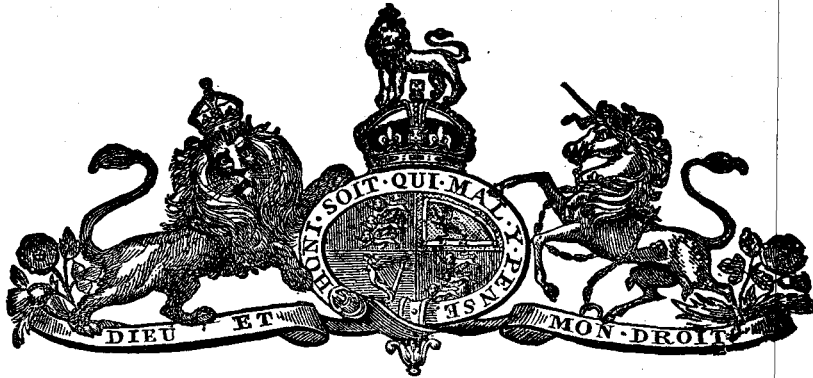

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

2 The Treasurer may issue out of the Consolidated Revenue, and apply towards making good the supply hereby granted to His Majesty for the service of the year ending the thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-six, the sum of one million two hundred and thirty-two thousand two hundred and sixty-two pounds seventeen shillings and seven pence.

3 All sums granted by this Act and the *Supply Act 1935-36*, out of the Consolidated Revenue towards making good the supply granted to His Majesty, amounting, as appears by the first schedule, in the aggregate to the sum of two million and thirty-two thousand four hundred and sixty-two pounds seventeen shillings and seven pence, are appropriated, and shall be deemed to have been appropriated as from the date of the passing of those Acts for the purposes and services expressed in the second schedule to this Act.
