AN ACT to grant and apply a Sum out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund to the Service of the Year ending on the Thirtieth day of June, One thousand nine hundred and forty, and to appropriate the Supplies granted for that Year in this Session of Parliament. [30 November, 1939.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 This Act may be cited as the Appropriation Act 1939-40, short title.

2 The Treasurer may issue out of the Consolidated Revenue, and apply towards making good the supply hereby granted to His Majesty for the service of the year ending the thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and forty, the sum of one million and thirteen thousand two hundred and eighty-nine pounds nine shillings and twopence.

3 All sums granted by this Act, and the Supply Act 1939-40, out of the Consolidated Revenue towards making good the supply granted to His Majesty, amounting, as appears by the first schedule, in the aggregate to the sum of one million seven hundred and five thousand six hundred and sixty-nine pounds nine shillings and twopence, are appropriated, and shall be deemed to have been appropriated as from the date of the passing of those Acts for the purposes and services expressed in the second schedule to this Act.
