**B**E it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

**2** The Treasurer may issue out of the Consolidated Revenue, and apply towards making good the supply hereby granted to His Majesty for the service of the year ending the thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and forty-four, the sum of one million one hundred and two thousand and forty-three pounds eleven shillings and eight pence.

**3** All sums granted by this Act, the *Supply Act* 1943-44, and the *Supply Act (No. 2)* 1943-44, out of the Consolidated Revenue towards making good the supply granted to His Majesty, amounting, as appears by the first schedule, in the aggregate to the sum of one million eight hundred and fifty-nine thousand three hundred and ninety-three pounds eleven shillings and eight pence, are appropriated and shall be deemed to have been appropriated as from the date of the passing of those Acts for the purposes and services expressed in the second schedule to this Act.
