## AN ACT to amend the Architects Act 1929. [25 November, 1943.]

Qualification for registration. 2 The Principal Act is hereby amended—

- I. As to section two—
  - (a) By deleting the words "but used" to "architecture" in the definition of "Architect": and
  - (b) By inserting after the word "Tasmanian" in the definition of "Institute" the words "Chapter of the Royal Australian":
- II. By repealing section thirteen and substituting therefor the following new section thirteen—
  - "13 Subject to this Act, any person—
    - I. Who has been engaged for a period of four years in the acquirement of a professional knowledge of architecture to the satisfaction of the Board, and has passed the prescribed examination: or
    - II. Who---
      - (a) Has completed a term of four years as a student articled to a duly registered architect practising as such in any part of the Commonwealth: and
      - (b) Is the holder of a certificate, diploma, degree, or licence of competency from any university, college, school, or public institution for the training of architects, the examinations for which are approved by the Royal Australian Institute of Architects—

shall be entitled to registration as an architect under this Act.": and

III. By expunging paragraphs III. and IV. of section twenty-six and renumbering paragraph "V." as "III.".
