AN ACT to grant and apply a Sum out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund to the Service of the Year ending on the Thirtieth day of June, One thousand nine hundred and forty-six, and to appropriate the Supplies granted for that Year in this and the preceding Session of Parliament.

B^E it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

Issue and application of £1,492,219 9s. 3d.

2 The Treasurer may issue out of the Consolidated Revenue, and apply towards making good the supply hereby granted to His Majesty for the service of the year ending the thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and fortysix, the sum of one million four hundred and ninety-two thousand two hundred and nineteen pounds nine shillings and threepence.

Appropriation of supplies.

3 All sums granted by this Act, the Supply Act 1945-46, and the Supply Act (No. 2) 1945-46, out of the Consolidated Revenue towards making good the supply granted to His Majesty, amounting, as appears by the first schedule, in the aggregate to the sum of two million two hundred and seventy-four thousand two hundred and thirty-nine pounds nine shillings and threepence, are appropriated and shall be deemed to have been appropriated as from the date of the passing of those Acts for the purposes and services expressed in the second schedule to this Act.

Date of commencement of certain regulations under the Education Act 1932.

4 The provisions of the regulations made under the *Education Act* 1932, and gazetted on the thirty-first day of October 1945, and the fourteenth day of November, 1945, respectively, relating to the payment of salaries and allowances to teachers, shall be deemed to have taken effect from the first day of July 1945.
