AN ACT to amend the Apprentices Act 1942.
[8 June, 1945.]

B^E it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

- 1—(1) This Act may be cited as the Apprentices Act 1945. Short title and citation.
- (2) The Apprentices Act 1942*, as amended by the Apprentices Act 1944, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.
- 2 Section ten of the Principal Act is amended by adding at Trade the end thereof the following subsection:—
- "(8) The members of a trade committee shall be entitled to be paid such allowances and expenses as may be prescribed.".
- 3 Section eleven of the Principal Act is amended by adding Advisory at the end thereof the following subsection:—
- "(3) The members of an advisory committee shall be entitled to be paid such allowances and expenses as may be prescribed.".
