AN ACT to amend the *Apprentices Act* 1942.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania,
by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative
Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled,
as follows:—

1—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Apprentices Act* 1945. Short title and citation.

(2) The *Apprentices Act* 1942*, as amended by the *Appren-
tices Act* 1944, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

2 Section ten of the Principal Act is amended by adding at the end thereof the following subsection:— Trade committees.

“(8) The members of a trade committee shall be entitled to be paid such allowances and expenses as may be prescribed.”.

3 Section eleven of the Principal Act is amended by adding at the end thereof the following subsection:— Advisory committees.

“(3) The members of an advisory committee shall be entitled to be paid such allowances and expenses as may be prescribed.”.
