AN ACT to amend the *Apprentices Act* 1942.
[29 March, 1946.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania,
by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative
Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled,
as follows:—

1—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Apprentices Act* Short title and citation.
1946.

(2) The *Apprentices Act* 1942* is in this Act referred to
as the Principal Act.

2 Section twenty-one of the Principal Act is amended by Apprentices to attend classes, &c.
omitting from subsection (2) the words “, not exceeding
four hours in each week,” and substituting therefor the
words “, equivalent, on the average, to not more than four
hours per week,”.
