AN ACT to amend the Apprentices Act 1942. [29 March, 1946.]

A.D. 1946

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

- 1—(1) This Act may be cited as the Apprentices Act Short title and citation.
- (2) The Apprentices Act 1942* is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.
- 2 Section twenty-one of the Principal Act is amended by Apprentices omitting from subsection (2) the words ", not exceeding classes, &c. four hours in each week," and substituting therefor the words ", equivalent, on the average, to not more than four hours per week,".
