## APPROPRIATION 1953-54.

## No. 24 of 1953.

AN ACT to grant and apply out of the Consolidated Revenue a sum for the service of the year ending on the thirtieth day of June, 1954, and to appropriate the supplies granted by Parliament for that year.
[20 October, 1953.]

$\mathrm{B}^{\mathrm{E}}$E it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:-

1 This Act may be cited as the Appropriation Act 1953-54. Short title.
2 The Treasurer may issue out of the Consolidated Revenue, lasue and and apply towards making good the supply hereby granted ${ }^{\text {apblication }}$ to Her Majesty for the service of the year ending on the thirtieth day of June, 1954, the sum of $£ 5,854,439$.

3 The sums granted by this Act and by the Supply Act 1953-54 out of the Consolidated Revenue towards making good the supply granted to Her Majesty for the service of the year ending on the thirtieth day of June, 1954, amounting as appears by the first schedule to the sum of $£ 8,374,049$, are appropriated and shall be deemed to have been appropriated, as from the first day of July, 1953, for the purposes and services expressed in the second schedule in relation to the financial year ending on the thirtieth day of June, 1954.
