AN ACT to amend the *Audit Act* 1918. [30 September 1960.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1—(1) This Act may be cited as the Audit Act 1960.

Short title, citation, and commencement

- (2) The Audit Act 1918, as subsequently amended, is in commence-this Act referred to as the Principal Act.
- (3) This Act shall be deemed to have commenced on the third day of December 1959.
- 2 Section five of the Principal Act is amended by omitting salary of from subsection (1) thereof the words "three thousand five Auditor-hundred" and substituting therefor the words "four thousand and twenty-five".
