

APPROPRIATION 1968-1969.

No. 44 of 1968.

AN ACT to grant and apply out of the Consolidated Revenue a sum for the service of the year ending on the thirtieth day of June 1969, and to appropriate the supplies granted by Parliament for that year. [22 October 1968.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 This Act may be cited as the *Appropriation Act 1968-1969*. Short title.

2 The Treasurer may issue out of the Consolidated Revenue, and apply towards making good the supply hereby granted to Her Majesty for the service of the year ending on the thirtieth day of June 1969 the sum of \$44,153,001. Issue and application of \$44,153,001.

3 The sums granted by this Act and by the *Supply Act 1968-1969* out of the Consolidated Revenue towards making good the supply granted to Her Majesty for the service of the year ending on the thirtieth day of June 1969, amounting as appears by the first schedule to the sum of \$65,589,301, are appropriated and shall be deemed to have been appropriated, as from the first day of July 1968, for the purposes and services expressed in the second schedule in relation to the financial year ending on the thirtieth day of June 1969. Appropriation of supplies.

LAND TAX.

No. 45 of 1968.

AN ACT to impose a land tax.

[22 October 1968.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Land Tax Act 1968*.

Short title and incorporation.

(2) This Act is incorporated, and shall be read as one, with the *Land and Income Taxation Act 1910* (in this Act referred to as the Principal Act).

2—(1) For the financial year ending on the thirtieth day of June 1969, the graduated land tax imposed by the Principal Act shall be paid in the cases and at the amounts and rates declared in the scale set forth in the schedule to this Act, but subject to the provisions of this section.
