AGENT-GENERAL.

No. 3 of 1969.

AN ACT to amend the Agent-General Act 1911. [25 July 1969.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

Short title, citation, and commencement.

- 1—(1) This Act may be cited as the Agent-General Act 1969.
- (2) The Agent-General Act 1911, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.
- (3) This Act shall be deemed to have commenced on the second day of February 1967.

2 Section seven of the Principal Act is amended—

Salary of Agent-General.

Short title.

- (a) by omitting subsection (1) of that section and substituting therefor the following subsection:—
 - "(1) The Agent-General shall be paid a salary at the rate of eight thousand two hundred dollars a year or at such other rate as is specified in an order under subsection (1B) of this section, being an order made after the commencement of this subsection."; and
- (b) by inserting in subsection (1B) of that section, after the words "basic salary" (wherever occurring), the words "or salary component".

AUDIT.

AN ACT to amend the Audit Act 1918. [25 July 1969.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

- 1—(1) This Act may be cited as the Audit Act 1969.
- (2) The Audit Act 1918, as subsequently amended, is in and commencement.
- (3) This Act shall be deemed to have commenced on the second day of February 1967.
