## AGENT-GENERAL.

No. 3 of 1969.

AN ACT to amend the *Agent-General Act* 1911.

[25 July 1969.]

**B**E it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

**1—(1)** This Act may be cited as the *Agent-General Act* 1969.

(2) The *Agent-General Act* 1911, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

(3) This Act shall be deemed to have commenced on the second day of February 1967.

**2** Section seven of the Principal Act is amended—Salary of  
Agent-  
General.

(a) by omitting subsection (1) of that section and substituting therefor the following subsection:—

“(1) The Agent-General shall be paid a salary at the rate of eight thousand two hundred dollars a year or at such other rate as is specified in an order under subsection (1B) of this section, being an order made after the commencement of this subsection.”; and

(b) by inserting in subsection (1B) of that section, after the words “basic salary” (wherever occurring), the words “or salary component”.
