# AN ACT to amend the Audit Act 1918. [25 July 1969.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, **D** by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :---

1-(1) This Act may be cited as the Audit Act 1969.

(2) The Audit Act 1918, as subsequently amended, is in and com-mencement. this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

(3) This Act shall be deemed to have commenced on the second day of February 1967.

Short title, citation, and commencement. **1**—(1) This Act may be cited as the Public Service Act 1969.
