

(2) The *Public Service Act* 1923, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

(3) This Act shall be deemed to have commenced on the eleventh day of September 1969.

2 Section six of the Principal Act is amended by omitting subsection (7) and substituting therefor the following subsection:— Appointment of Commissioner.

“(7) The Commissioner shall be paid a salary—

- (a) during the period commencing on the eleventh day of September 1969 and ending on the thirty-first day of December 1969, at the rate of fourteen thousand two hundred and fifty-four dollars a year; and
- (b) thereafter, at the rate of fourteen thousand six hundred and eighty-two dollars a year.”.

AN ACT to amend the *Audit Act* 1918.

[29 April 1970.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Audit Act* 1970.

Short title, citation, and commencement.

(2) The *Audit Act* 1918, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

(3) This Act shall be deemed to have commenced on the eleventh day of September 1969.

2 Section five of the Principal Act is amended by omitting subsection (1) and substituting therefor the following subsection:— Salary of Auditor-General.

“(1) The Auditor-General shall be paid a salary—

- (a) during the period commencing on the eleventh day of September 1969 and ending on the thirty-first day of December 1969, at the rate of fourteen thousand two hundred and fifty-four dollars a year; and
- (b) thereafter, at the rate of fourteen thousand six hundred and eighty-two dollars a year.”.
