

AGENT-GENERAL.**No. 19 of 1970.**

AN ACT to amend the *Agent-General Act* 1911.

[18 June 1970.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

Short title,
citation, and

1—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Agent-General Act* 1970.

(2) The *Agent-General Act* 1911, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

(3) This Act shall be deemed to have commenced on the first day of January 1970.

Salary of

2 Section seven of the Principal Act is amended—

(a) by omitting subsection (1) of that section and substituting therefor the following subsection:—

“(1) The Agent-General shall be paid a salary—

(a) at the rate of nine thousand four hundred and fifty dollars a year; or

(b) such other rate as the Governor, on the recommendation of the Public Service Tribunal, may, after the first day of January 1971, determine.”; and

(b) by inserting in subsection (1B) of that section, after the word “Agent-General” (first occurring), the words “, pursuant to paragraph (a) or paragraph (b) of subsection (1) of this section,”.
