## JUSTICES PROCEDURE.

## 11 GEO. VI. No. 11.

# AN ACT to amend the Justices Procedure Act 1919. [22 April, 1947.]

**B**<sup>E</sup> it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

**1**—(1) This Act may be cited as the Justices Procedure Act 1947.

(2) The Justices Procedure Act 1919\*, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

**2** After section eighty-six of the Principal Act the following section is inserted:—

"86A. When a person has been admitted to bail in accordance with section eighty-five or section eighty-six, the recognisance may be conditioned for his appearance at every time and place to which, during the course of the proceedings, the hearing may be from time to time adjourned.".

**3** Section one hundred and thirteen of the Principal Act is amended by adding at the end thereof the following subsection:—

" (2) Where two or more sentences, imposed in accordance with this section, are ordered to run consecutively, the aggregate term of imprisonment shall not exceed two years.".
