

APPROPRIATION (No. 2).

No. 64 of 1954.

AN ACT to grant and apply out of the Consolidated Revenue a sum for the service of the year ending on the thirtieth day of June 1955.

[16 December, 1954.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 This Act may be cited as the *Appropriation Act (No. 2)* Short title. 1954-55.

2 The Treasurer may issue out of the Consolidated Revenue, and apply towards making good the supply hereby granted to Her Majesty for the service of the year ending on the thirtieth day of June 1955, the sum of £165,313. Issue and application of £165,313.

3 The sum granted by this Act out of the Consolidated Revenue towards making good the supply granted to Her Majesty for the service of the year ending on the thirtieth day of June 1955, is appropriated and shall be deemed to have been appropriated, as from the first day of July 1954, for the purposes expressed in the schedule in relation to the financial year ending on the thirtieth day of June 1955. Appropriation of supplies.
