Provision of funds

> 6 The Governor may make regulations for the purposes of this Act prescribing all matters which are required or permitted to be prescribed or are necessary or convenient to be prescribed for carrying out and giving effect to this Act, and in particular prescribing---

- (a) the rates of contributions to associations or organizations for the purposes of this Act;
- (b) the enrolment and training of women and girls for domestic assistance in homes:
- (c) the terms and conditions of employment of domestic assistants whose services are provided by the domestic assistance service established under this Act or approved associations or organizations; and
- (d) the payments to be made by householders in respect of the provision of domestic assistance under this Act.

- (c) by omitting sub-paragraph (h) of paragraph II. of subsection (2) and substituting therefor the following sub-paragraph:—
 - "(h) One shall be appointed to represent the Tasmanian Farmers' Federation.".
