AN ACT to amend the Alcohol and Drug Dependency Act 1968.

[31 August 1977]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Alcohol and Drug Dependency Act 1977*. Short title and citation.

(2) The *Alcohol and Drug Dependency Act 1968**, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

2 Section 8 of the Principal Act is amended by adding at the end the following subsections:—

“(8) The members of the Board are not, as such, subject to the *Public Service Act 1973*, but an officer of the Public Service may hold office as a member of the Board in conjunction with his office in the Public Service.

“(9) Subject to subsection (10), the Minister may pay to a member of the Board such remuneration and allowances as the Governor may approve.

“(10) Except with the approval of—

- (a) the Public Service Board, no remuneration shall be paid under subsection (9) to a member of the Board who is an officer of the Public Service; or
- (b) the Commission, no remuneration shall be so paid to a member of the Board who is an officer of the mental health service.”.

3 Section 11 of the Principal Act is amended—

- (a) by adding at the end of subsection (3) the words “and may, with the approval of the Public Service Board, include officers of the Public Service and, with the approval of the Commission, include officers of the mental health service”;
- (b) by omitting from subsection (6) the word “The” and substituting the words “Subject to subsection (7), the”;
- (c) by inserting in that subsection, after the word “remuneration”, the words “and allowances”; and
- (d) by adding at the end the following subsection:—

“(7) Except with the approval of—

- (a) the Public Service Board, no remuneration shall be paid under subsection (6) to a member of a committee appointed under this section who is an officer of the Public Service; or
- (b) the Commission, no remuneration shall be so paid to a member of such a committee who is an officer of the mental health service.”.

4 Nothing in this Act shall be construed as affecting—

- (a) the appointment or term of office of an officer of the Public Service appointed before the commencement of this Act as a member of the Board or as a member of a committee under section 11 of the Principal Act; or
- (b) the appointment or term of office of an officer of the mental health service appointed before that commencement as a member of such a committee.
