AN ACT for appropriating certain Sums arising A.D. 1880. from the Scab Act Fund to the Service of the Colony of *Tasmania* for the Years 1880 and 1881. [1 November, 1880.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :---

1 Out of the Scab Act Fund there shall and may be appropriated, issued, and applied, in the manner hereinafter provided, for the several purposes hereinafter mentioned, any sum of money not exceeding in amount respectively the several sums of money hereinafter specified; that is to say,

Moneys payable by Warrant of the Governor.

Credit to be given to the Treasurer in account.

2 The Colonial Treasurer shall issue and pay the said several sums to such persons for the purposes hereinbefore mentioned, upon such days and in such proportions as the Governor, by any Warrant under his hand, from time to time, orders and directs; and the payments so to be made shall be charged upon and payable out of the Scab Act Fund.

3 The said Treasurer shall be allowed credit in his Accounts for any sums of money paid by him in pursuance of any such Warrant as aforesaid; and the receipts of the respective persons to whom the same are so paid shall be a full and valid discharge to the said Treasurer in passing his said Accounts for any such sums as are therein mentioned, and he shall receive credit for the same accordingly.
