## VICTORIÆ REGINÆ,

*By His Excellency SIR JOHN FRANKLIN, Knight Commander of the Royal Hanoverian Guelphic Order, Knight of the Greek Order of the Redeemer, and a Captain in Her Majesty's Royal Navy, Lieutenant-Governor of the Island of Van Diemen's Land and its Dependencies, with the advice of the Legislative Council.*

*AN ACT for extending to this Colony a certain Act of Parliament passed in the Third and Fourth Year of Her present Majesty intituled An Act to repeal part of an Act of the Forty-third Year of the Reign of Queen Elizabeth intituled An Act to avoid trifling and frivolous Suits in Law in Her Majesty's Courts in Westminster and of an Act of the Twenty-second and Twenty-third Year of the Reign of King Charles the Second intituled An Act for laying Impositions on Proceedings at Law and to make further Provisions in lieu thereof.*

PREAMBLE.

**W**HEREAS a certain Act of Parliament was passed in the Third and Fourth Year of Her present Majesty intituled *An Act to repeal part of an Act of the Forty-third Year of the Reign of Queen Elizabeth intituled An Act to avoid trifling and frivolous Suits in Law in Her Majesty's Courts in Westminster and of an Act of the Twenty-second and Twenty-third Year of the Reign of King Charles the Second intituled An Act for laying Impositions on Proceedings at Law and to make further Provisions in lieu thereof*—AND WHEREAS it is expedient to adopt and apply the said recited Act of Parliament in the Administration of Justice in the Island of Van Diemen's Land and its Dependencies—BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by His Excellency SIR JOHN FRANKLIN Knight Commander of the Royal Hanoverian Guelphic Order Knight of the Greek Order of the Redeemer and a Captain in Her Majesty's Royal Navy Lieutenant-Governor of the

Island of Van Diemen's Land and its Dependencies by and with the advice of the Legislative Council that the said recited Act of Parliament and every clause provision and enactment therein respectively contained shall be and the same are and is hereby adopted and directed to be applied in the Administration of Justice in the said Island and its Dependencies in like manner as other Laws of England are therein applied.
