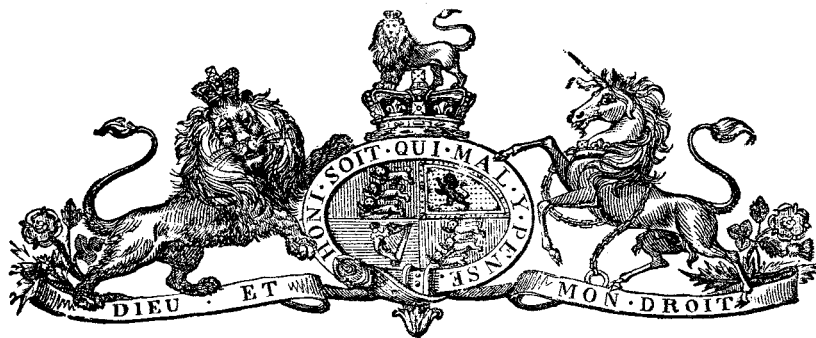

AN ACT for raising the Sum of £24,000 by Debentures for the Service of the Year 1857. [5 June, 1857.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 Towards making good the Supply granted to Her Majesty for the service of the year 1857, it shall be lawful for the Governor in Council to cause to be raised a sum not exceeding £24,000 in the whole by the issue and sale of Debentures secured on the General Revenue, in like manner as is prescribed in the Act of the Parliament of *Tasmania* 20th *Victoria*, No. 9, such Debentures to be redeemable as follows; that is to say—

- As to the amount of £8000 in the year 1867;
As to the amount of £8000 in the year 1868;
As to the amount of £8000 in the year 1869.

2 All and every the clauses, provisions, powers, penalties, forfeitures, and disabilities contained in the said recited Act shall be applied and extended to the Debentures to be issued in pursuance of this Act, as fully and effectually to all intents and purposes as if the several clauses, provisions, powers, penalties, forfeitures, and disabilities had been particularly repeated and re-enacted in the body of this Act.
