AN ACT further Supplementary to the Act for appropriating a certain Sum from the Land Fund to the Service of the Colony of Tasmania [20 February, 1867.] for the Year 1864.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:-

1 Out of the Land Fund of the Colony of *Tasmania* there shall and may be appropriated, issued, and applied, in the manner hereinafter provided, for the purpose hereinafter mentioned, any sum of money not exceeding in amount respectively the sum of money hereinafter specified; that is to say,

Amount transferred to General Revenue to make good the deficiency in the General Revenue for the Year 1864 from the Surplus of the Land Fund of that year. (Resolutions of the House of Assembly of 16 August, 1865, and Legislative Council of 28

2 The Colonial Treasurer shall issue and pay the said sum to such Moneys payable persons for the purposes hereinbefore mentioned, upon such days by Warrant of and in such proportions as the Governor, by any Warrant under his Governor. hand, from time to time, orders and directs; and the payments so to be made shall be charged upon and payable out of the Land Fund.

Supplementary Appropriation, Land Fund, 1864.

Credit to be given to the Treasurer in Account.

3 The said Treasurer shall be allowed credit in his Accounts for any sums of money paid by him in pursuance of any such Warrant as aforesaid; and the receipts of the respective persons to whom the same are so paid shall be a full and valid discharge to the said Treasurer in passing his said Accounts for any such sums as are therein mentioned, and he shall receive credit for the same accordingly.
