

AN ACT further Supplementary to the Act for A.D. 1882. appropriating certain Sums arising from the Consolidated Revenue Fund to the Service of the Colony of *Tasmania* for the Year 1882.

[9 October, 1882.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as tollows:—

1 Out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund of the Colony of *Tasmania* there shall and may be appropriated, issued, and applied, in the manner hereinafter provided, for the service of the year 1882, for the several purposes hereinafter mentioned, any sum of money not exceeding in amount respectively the several sums of money hereinafter specified; that is to say,—

Supplementary Appropriation, Consolidated Revenue Fund, 1882.

2 The Colonial Treasurer shall issue and pay the said several sums A.D. 1882. to such persons for the purposes hereinbefore mentioned, upon such days and in such proportions as the Governor, by any Warrant under his hand, from time to time, orders and directs; and the payments so to be made shall be charged upon and payable out of the Consolidated Payments Fund of the soid Colors. solidated Revenue Fund of the said Colony.

3 The said Treasurer shall be allowed credit in his Accounts for Credit to be given any sums of money paid by him in pursuance of any such Warrant as to the Treasurer aforesaid; and the receipts of the respective persons to whom the same in Account. are so paid shall be a full and valid discharge to the said Treasurer in passing his said Accounts for any such sums as are therein mentioned, and he shall receive credit for the same accordingly.
