AN ACT to amend the Administration and Probate Act 1935. [31 August 1977]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

- 1—(1) This Act may be cited as the Administration and Probate Short title and Act 1977.
- (2) The Administration and Probate Act 1935*, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

Succession on intestacy.

2 Section 44 of the Principal Act is amended by omitting from subsections (2), (3), and (4) "\$17 000" wherever occurring and substituting "\$50 000" in each case.

Application of amendment.

3 The amendment effected by section 2 does not apply in relation to the estate of any person who died before the commencement of this Act.
