

AN ACT Supplementary to the Acts for A.D. 1886 appropriating certain Sums arising from Revenue Fund to the Consolidated the Service of the Colony of Tasmania for the Years 1884, 1885, and 1886.

[8 December, 1886.]

**D**E it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of 

1 Out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund of the Colony of Tasmania there shall and may be appropriated, issued, and applied, in the manner hereinafter provided, for the service of the years 1884, 1885, and 1886, for the several purposes specified in the Schedule, any sum or sums of money not exceeding in amount respectively the several sums of money therein specified.

2 The Treasurer shall issue and pay the said several sums Moneys payable to such persons for the purposes hereinbefore mentioned, upon such by Warrant of days and in such proportions as the Governor, by any Warrant under Governor. his hand, from time to time, orders and directs; and the payments so to be made shall be charged upon and payable out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund of the said Colony.

Supplementary Appropriation, Consolidated Revenue Fund, 1884, 1885, § 1886.

#### A.D. 1886.

Credit to be given to the Treasurer in Accounts. **3** The said Treasurer shall be allowed credit in his Accounts for any sums of money paid by him in pursuance of any such Warrant as aforesaid; and the receipts of the respective persons to whom the same are so paid shall be a full and valid discharge to the said Treasurer in passing his said Accounts for any such sums as are therein mentioned, and he shall receive credit for the same accordingly.
