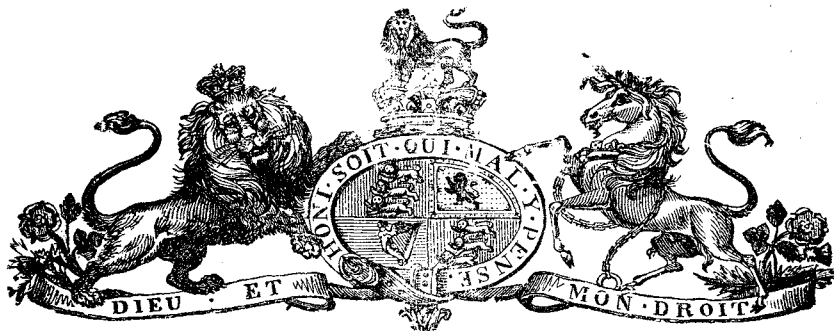

AN ACT Supplementary to the Act for appropriating certain Sums arising from the Consolidated Revenue Fund to the Service of the State of *Tasmania* for the Year 1901. A.D. 1901.
[30 December, 1901.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

1 Out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund of the State of *Tasmania* there shall and may be appropriated, issued, and applied for the Service of the Year One thousand nine hundred and one, the sum of Two thousand Pounds, as an allowance to the Administrator of the Government to defray expenses in connection with the visit of Their Royal Highnesses the Duke and Duchess of *Cornwall* and *York*. Appropriation.

Supplementary Appropriation, 1901.

Credit to be given
to the Treasurer
in Accounts.

2 The Treasurer shall be allowed, in respect of such allowance, credit in his Accounts for such sum of money paid by him as aforesaid; and the receipts of the Administrator of the Government shall be a full and valid discharge to the said Treasurer in passing his said Accounts for such sum, and he shall receive credit for the same accordingly.
