## VICTORIÆ REGINÆ,

No. 3.

By His Excellency SIR WILLIAM THOMAS DENISON, Knight, Lieutenant-Governor of the Island of Van Diemen's Land and its Dependencies, with the Advice of the Legislative Council.

AN ACT supplementary to the Act for the general Appropriation of the Revenue for the Year One thousand eight hundred and forty-nine.

WHEREAS by the Act of this Island passed on the second day of January one thousand eight hundred and thirty-four for confirming and continuing certain duties of Customs and Duties on Spirits it was enacted that the several Duties by that Act imposed should be thereafter applied in such manner and to such purposes as by any Act or Acts thereafter passed for the Appropriation of the Revenue should be appointed—AND WHEREAS it is expedient that all other the Colonial Revenue should in like manner be from time to time appropriated by Legislative Authority—

BE IT ENACTED by His Excellency SIR WILLIAM THOMAS DENISON Knight Lieutenant-Governor of the Island of Van Diemen's Land and its Dependencies with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council that out of the produce of the said several Duties and the produce of all or any other the Public Revenue of this Island there shall or may be issued and applied in the manner hereinafter mentioned any sum or sums of money not exceeding in amount respectively the several sums of money hereinafter specified—that is to say—

FIRST—For defraying the charge of the Civil Establishments of this Island and its Dependencies for the said year one thousand eight hundred and forty-nine as hereinafter particularly specified the sum of three hundred and two pounds eleven shillings and two pence—
