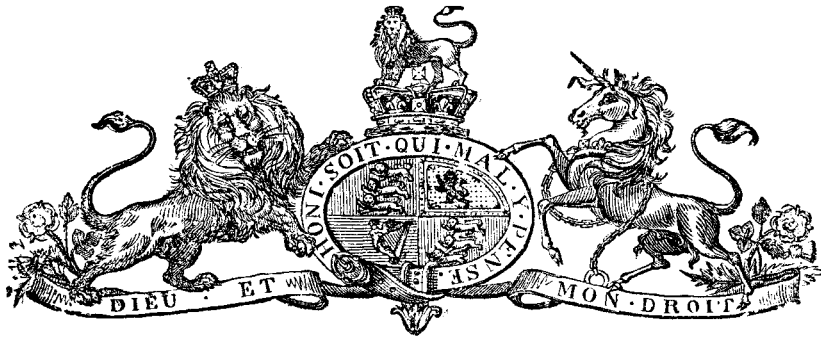

AN ACT to amend an Act, intituled *An Act to provide for the Protection of Native Game during the Breeding Season.*

[1 February, 1862.]

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend an Act, intituled *An Act to provide for the Protection of Native Game during the Breeding Season*: Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

PREAMBLE.

1 So much of Section 2 of the said Act as imposes any penalty upon any person for killing, taking, or having in his possession or control, any Wild Ducks, Teal, Plover, or Bronze-winged Pigeons, between the Twentieth day of *August* in any year and the Twentieth day of *April* in any succeeding year, is hereby repealed.

2 If any person, by any means whatsoever, kills or takes, or has in his possession or control, either on his own land or on that of any other person, any Wild Ducks, Teal, Plover, or Bronze-winged Pigeons, which shall have been killed or taken between the First day of *September* in any year and the Tenth day of *January* in any succeeding year, every such person shall, for every head of Wild Duck, Teal, Plover, or Bronze-winged Pigeon so killed or taken by him, or so found in his possession or control, incur a penalty not exceeding Twenty Shillings.

Penalty for killing, &c., Wild Ducks, &c.

3 This Act and the said recited Act, except so far as the same is altered by this Act, shall be read and construed together as one and the same Act.
