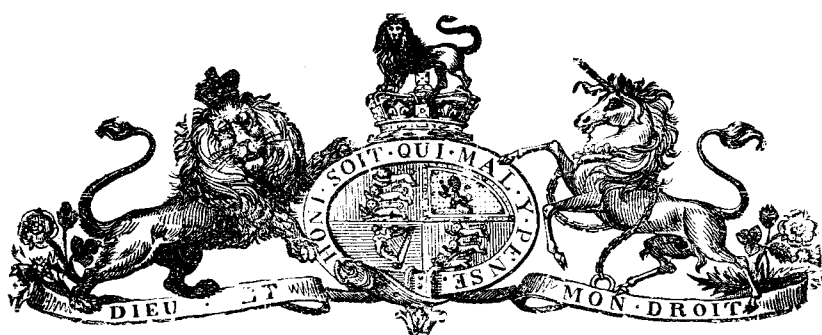

AN ACT to authorise an additional Loan of A.D. 1899.
Three thousand Pounds to the Board of the
Town of *Zeehan*, in accordance with the
provisions of "The Local Public Works
Loans Act, 1890," and for other purposes.
[1 *December*, 1899.]

WHEREAS the Town Board of the Town of *Zeehan* are desirous of making certain further Improvements to the Streets of the Town of *Zeehan*, and are desirous of obtaining the necessary money to enable them to do so under the provisions of "The Local Public Works Loans Act, 1890":

PREAMBLE.

And whereas a Poll of the Electors of the Town of *Zeehan* has been taken, and at such Poll the said Electors approved of the Board of the said Town borrowing the sum of Three thousand Pounds for the purposes aforesaid:

Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 In this Act, unless the context otherwise determines, "Board" shall mean the Town Board of the Town of *Zeehan* as proclaimed. Interpretation

2 It shall be lawful for the Board to borrow any sum or sums of money not exceeding Three thousand Pounds for the purpose of defray- The Board may borrow money.

3 It shall be lawful for the Governor in Council to grant, in accordance with the provisions of "The Local Public Works Loans Act, 1890," the Sum of Three thousand Pounds as an additional loan to the said Board for Street Improvements in the said Town of *Zeehan*, and such sum of money shall be defrayed out of moneys to be provided by Parliament for that purpose: Provided that it shall not be necessary to lay before both Houses of Parliament plans and specifications of any proposed improvements, nor the Report of the Engineer-in-Chief thereon, as provided in Section Two of the said Acts.

in erecting offices.

4 It shall be lawful for the said Board to expend in and towards the erection of Town Board offices, any sum of money not exceeding the sum of Three hundred and Fifty Pounds out of the sum of Six thousand Pounds authorised to be borrowed by the said Board, under the provisions of the said Act of the Parliament of *Tasmania*, 61 *Victoriæ*, No. 19.
