AN ACT to amend an Act passed in the Second Year of the Reign of Her present Majesty intituled An Act to promote the Circulation of the Dollars of the several States of South America and of Mexico.

WHEREAS an Act was passed in the Second Year of the reign of Her present Majesty Queen Victoria intituled An Act to promote the Circulation of the Dollars of the several States of South America and of Mexico—AND WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the said Act in such manner as that its provisions shall apply only to Dollars of the full intrinsic value of the Spanish Dollar—BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by His Excellency Sir John Franklin Knight Commander of the Royal Hanoverian Guelphic Order Knight of the Greek Order of the Redeemer and a Captain in Her Majesty's Royal Navy Lieutenant-Governor of this Island and its Dependencies by and with the advice of the Legislative Council that on and after the First day of October next on which day this Act shall commence the provisions of the said recited Act shall not be applied to Dollars of any coinage of a sandard inferior to that of the Spanish Dollar which is Seventeen ennyweights Eight Grains Troy Weight and Three hundred and seventy Grains and nine-tenths of a Grain of pure Silver.
