## AN ACT to amend a Clerical Error in "The Jury Act." [28th August, 1855.]

WHEREAS by the Nineteenth Section of "The Jury Act" it was Preamble. amongst other things enacted that, upon the receipt of any such Precept 18 Vict., No. 11. as in the said Act mentioned, the Sheriff should forthwith issue a Summons, in writing, to the several Jurors so required to be summoned as in the said Act mentioned, signed by himself or his Deputy, to the effect in the Schedule C. to the said Act annexed: And whereas by a clerical error the letter "C." has been inserted in the said recited Section of the said Act in the stead of the letter "D.:" Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Van Diemen's Land, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council, that "The Jury Act" shall "The Jury Act" be deemed, construed, and taken to have had and to have such and to be read as if D. the same effect, to all intents and purposes whatsoever, as if the letter in 19th section. "D." had been originally inserted after the word "Schedule" in the said recited Section of the said Act in the stead of the said letter "C."
