

AN ACT to amend a clerical Error in the A.D. 1886. Schedule (2.) to "The Electoral Act, No. 7," and to make provision for the Preparation of the Electoral Roll and Polling List of the Electoral District of Meander.

[18 October, 1886.]

W HEREAS by a clerical error the words "and that portion of the PREAMBLE. Assembly District of East Devon which is not included in the District of Mersey" were omitted to be inserted as part of the description of the Electoral District of Meander after the word "described" in the Schedule (2.) to "The Electoral Act, No. 7":

Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:-

1 "The Electoral Act, No. 7," shall be deemed, construed, and taken Amendment in to have had and to have such and the same effect to all intents and Schedule (2.) of purposes whatsoever as if the words "and that portion of the Assembly 49 Vict. No. 12. District of East Devon which is not included in the District of Mersey had been originally inserted as part of the description of the Electoral District of *Meander*, after the word "described" in the Schedule (2.) to "The Electoral Act, No. 7," which description is correctly set forth in the Schedule to this Act, and may be printed as set forth therein in all copies of "The Electoral Act, No. 7," printed after the commencement of this Act.

Meander Electoral District.

A.D. 1886.

Electoral Roll, &c. for *Meander* to continue in force until 10th *April*, 1887.

2 Notwithstanding anything to the contrary in any former Act contained, the Electoral Roll and Polling List of the Electoral District of *Meander* prepared in pursuance of a Proclamation of the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, made under and by virtue of Section Two of the 49th *Victoriæ*, No. 9, and bearing date the Eighteenth day of *January*, 1886, shall be used in the Election of a Member to serve in the Legislative Council for the said District until the Tenth day of *April*, 1887, and no longer.

New Electoral Roll, &c. for Meander to be made out. 3 The Clerk of the Peace at Hobart, and the Returning Officer and the Court of Revision of and for the said Electoral District of Meander, shall execute the duties imposed upon them by Part Two of The Electoral Act with reference to the preparation of the Electoral Roll and Polling List of such District to come into force on the Eleventh day of April, 1887, in the same manner in all respects as if the beforementioned Act of the 49th Victoriæ, No. 9, had not been passed, except that nothing in this Section contained shall render it necessary for the said Clerk of the Peace to cause to be published the notice mentioned and referred to in Section Twelve of The Electoral Act. The Electoral Roll and Polling List prepared in pursuance of this Act shall be used in the election of a Member to serve in the Legislative Council for the said Electoral District of Meander on and from the said Eleventh day of April, 1887, and until the Tenth day of April, 1888.

Acts to be read together.

4 The Electoral Act, and every Act amending or altering it, save so far as the same may be amended or altered by this Act, and this Act, shall be read and construed together as one Act.

SCHEDULE.

MEANDER.

Comprises the Assembly District of *Deloraine* as hereinafter described, and that portion of the Assembly District of *East Devon* which is not included in the District of *Mersey*.
