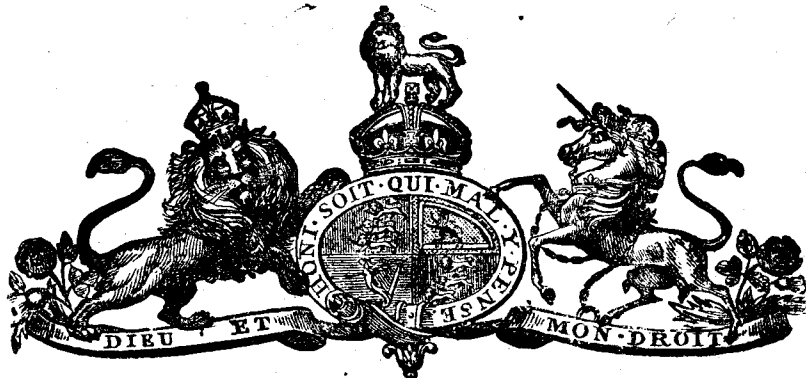

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AN ACT to authorise a Loan of One thousand one hundred Pounds to the Council of the Municipality of *St. Leonards*, in accordance with the provisions of "The Local Public Works Loans Act, 1890," and for other purposes.

WHEREAS the Council of the Municipality of *St. Leonards* (being the Local Board of Health thereof) has decided to construct a drain or sewer for the purpose of conveying sewage from *Lawrence Vale*, within the said Municipality, to the sewer of the City of *Launceston* :

PREAMBLE.

And whereas the Council of the Corporation of the City of *Launceston* has agreed that the sewer from *Lawrence Vale* may connect and discharge into the sewers of the City of *Launceston* without any charge or payment :

And whereas the said Council is desirous of obtaining legislative authority to borrow the money necessary to carry out the proposed work under the provisions of "The Local Public Works Loans Act, 1890 :"

And whereas the proposition upon the question of whether or not such money should be borrowed for the purposes aforesaid was advertised, as required by law, but no poll of ratepayers was asked for, and the said proposition was subsequently confirmed by the said Council:

And whereas the plans, drawings, and specifications of the proposed work have been approved by the Engineer-in-Chief:

Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

Interpretation.

**1** In this Act, unless the contrary intention appears—

“Council” means the Council of the Municipality of *St. Leonards*:

“Council Clerk” means the Council Clerk of the Municipality of *St. Leonards*.

Power to borrow.

**2** It shall be lawful for the Council of the Municipality of *St. Leonards* to borrow any sum of money, not exceeding One thousand one hundred Pounds, for the purpose of constructing a drain or sewer, and making certain connections therewith to convey sewage from the area bounded by *Melbourne* and *High* streets and the *Hobart* and *Wellington* roads, and known as *Lawrence Vale*, within the said municipality, to the sewer of the City of *Launceston*.

Power to lend.

**3** It shall be lawful for the Governor to grant, in accordance with the provisions of “The Local Public Works Loans Act, 1890,” any sum of money, not exceeding One thousand one hundred Pounds, as a loan to the Council of the Municipality of *St. Leonards*, for the purpose mentioned in the preceding section, and such sum shall be defrayed out of moneys to be provided by Parliament for the purpose.

Council may make sewers.

**4** The Council may cause to be made such sewers through or under any street or place or private property in the said area as may be necessary for connecting same with the sewers in *Launceston*, and may open and break up the soil and pavement of any such street, or place, or private property, either in the construction, alterations, or repairs of such sewers.

Power to stop up street during progress of work.

**5** The Council may, if at any time it is necessary during the construction, alteration, or repairs of any sewer, cause to be stopped up all or any such part of the carriage or footway of any street in the said area for such period as may be reasonably necessary for the due execution of such work.
