

AN ACT to authorise a Loan of Ten thousand Pounds to the Marine Board of Mersey, in accordance with the provisions of "The Local Public Works Loans Act, 1890."
[11 November, 1904.]

BBE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :-

1 It shall be lawful for the Governor in Council to grant, in accord- Loan to be ance with the provisions of "The Local Public Works Loans Act, granted to the 1890," a sum of money not exceeding Ten thousand Pounds, as a Loan to the Marine Board of Mersey, for construction of Training Wall Mersey Marine Board. and otherwise improving the entrance to the Harbour and widening and deepening the Channel throughout and including Police Point and Inner Harbour ; but no portion of this Loan shall be used for any work which, in the opinion of the Engineer-in-Chief, should be properly charged to maintenance; and such moneys shall be defrayed out of moneys to be provided by Parliament for that purpose: Provided always, that the proviso to Section Two of the said Act shall not apply

to the Loan authorised by this Act ; but before any part of the said sum of Ten thousand Pounds shall be advanced to the Buard, plans and specifications of the proposed works, together with a report by the Engineer-in-Chief upon the necessity of such works and probable cost thereof, the sufficiency of the plans and specifications, and upon such other matters conuected with the works as the Engineer-in-Chief may deem it desirable to refer to in the said report, and that the works can be completed for the amount proposed to be borrowed, shall be submitted to and approved by the Governor.
