## REGINÆ. VICTORIÆ

No. 1.

AN ACT to appropriate a Sum arising from A.D. 1894. the Consolidated Revenue Fund to the Service of the Colony of Tasmania for the Year One thousand eight hundred and ninety-four. [13 July, 1894.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows: --

1 Out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund of the Colony of Tasmania Appropriation of there shall and may be appropriated, issued, and applied the Supplies. sum of Two hundred and thirty-nine thousand seven hundred and twelve Pounds Three Shillings and One Penny, for the Service of the year One thousand eight hundred and ninety-four, for the purposes expressed in the Schedule to the Act of Parliament 57 Victoria, No. 37.

2 The said sum of Two hundred and thirty-nine thousand seven Money in addition hundred and twelve Pounds Three Shillings and One Penny shall to former Vote. be in addition to the sum of a like amount voted by the Act of Parliament 57 Victoria, No. 37; and notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained in the said Act, any money appropriated by the said Act may be applied from time to time for and towards similar Establishments or Services for the year 1894.

3 This Act and the said Act shall be read and construed together as Acts to be read one Act.
