

AN ACT to appropriate a Sum arising from A.D. 1902. the Consolidated Revenue Fund to the Service of the State of *Tasmania* for the Year ending the Thirty-first day of *De*-

[20 December, 1902.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House

of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 Out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund of the State of Tasmania Appropriation of there shall and may be appropriated, issued, and applied the sum of Supplies. Four hundred and sixty-seven thousand nine hundred and sixteen Pounds Fourteen Shillings and Eleven Pence for the Service of the year ending the Thirty-first day of December, One thousand nine hundred and three, for the purposes expressed in the Schedule hereto for the Schedule. year One thousand nine hundred and three.

2 The Treasurer shall issue and pay the several sums to such persons Moneys payable for the purposes in the said Schedule mentioned, upon such days and in such proportions as the Governor, by any Warrant under his hand, the Governor.

from time to time, orders and directs; and the payments so to be made shall be charged upon and payable out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund.

Credit to be given to the Treasurer in Accounts.

3 The said Treasurer shall be allowed credit in his Accounts for any sums of money paid by him in pursuance of any such Warrant as aforesaid; and the receipts of the respective persons to whom the same are so paid shall be a full and valid discharge to the said Treasurer in passing his said Accounts for any such sums as are therein mentioned, and he shall receive credit for the same accordingly.

Rates of pension of officers of Civil Service not affected by reduction.

4 The amount of pension or superannuation allowance which may at any time hereafter be granted to any officer of the Civil Service shall not be lessened or diminished in consequence of the salary and emoluments provided by this Act for such officer for the year 1903 being less in amount than the salary and emoluments voted for such officer for the year 1893, but such pension or superannuation allowance shall be computed as if such officer had actually received during the year 1903 the salary and emoluments provided for such officer for the year 1893 in the Schedule (1.) of the Act of the Parliament 56 Victoriæ, No. 47, intituled "An Act to appropriate a sum arising from the Consolidated Revenue Fund to the Service of the Colony of Tasmania for the year 1893," without the deductions mentioned in Schedule (2.) of the said Act.
