AN ACT to appropriate a Sum not exceeding A.D. 1879.
£4000 from the Consolidated Revenue Fund to the Service of the Colony of Tasmania for √6 October, 1879.7 the Year 1878.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:-

1 Out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund of the Colony of Aid to Road Tasmania there shall and may be appropriated, issued, and applied, in the manner hereinafter provided, any sums of money not exceeding in the whole £4000 for the purpose of paying claims for grants in aid to Road Trusts on account of the year 1878 in excess of the moneys applicable to that purpose under Sections 99 and 100 of the Act 34 Victoria, No. 10.

2 The Colonial Treasurer shall issue and pay the said several sums Moneys payable to such persons for the purposes hereinbefore mentioned, upon such by Warrant days and in such proportions as the Governor, by any Warrant under of the Governor his hand, from time to time, orders and directs; and the payments so to be made shall be charged upon and payable out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund.

3 The said Treasurer shall be allowed credit in his Accounts for Credit to be given any sums of money paid by him in pursuance of any such Warrant to the Treasurer as aforesaid; and the receipts of the respective persons to whom the in account. same are so paid shall be a full and valid discharge to the said Treasurer in passing his said Accounts for any such sums as are therein mentioned, and he shall receive credit for the same accordingly.
