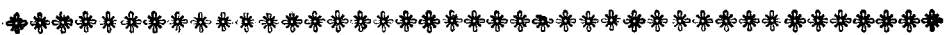

AN ACT to appropriate a Sum not exceeding A.D. 1879.
£4000 from the Consolidated Revenue Fund
to the Service of the Colony of *Tasmania* for
the Year 1878. [6 October, 1879.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 Out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund of the Colony of *Tasmania* there shall and may be appropriated, issued, and applied, in the manner hereinafter provided, any sums of money not exceeding in the whole £4000 for the purpose of paying claims for grants in aid to Road Trusts on account of the year 1878 in excess of the moneys applicable to that purpose under Sections 99 and 100 of the Act 34 *Victoria*, No. 10. Aid to Road Trusts.

2 The Colonial Treasurer shall issue and pay the said several sums to such persons for the purposes hereinbefore mentioned, upon such days and in such proportions as the Governor, by any Warrant under his hand, from time to time, orders and directs; and the payments so to be made shall be charged upon and payable out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund. Moneys payable by Warrant of the Governor

3 The said Treasurer shall be allowed credit in his Accounts for any sums of money paid by him in pursuance of any such Warrant as aforesaid; and the receipts of the respective persons to whom the same are so paid shall be a full and valid discharge to the said Treasurer in passing his said Accounts for any such sums as are therein mentioned, and he shall receive credit for the same accordingly. Credit to be given to the Treasurer in account.
