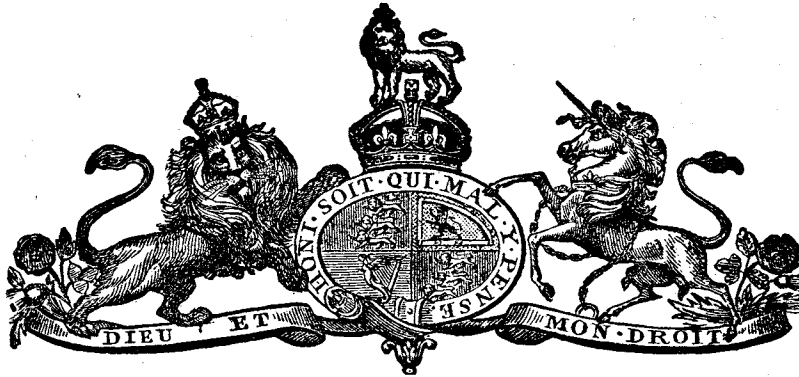

AN ACT to amend "An Act to provide for the Licensing of Hawkers and Carriers." A.D. 1904.

[5 July, 1904.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

Substitution for Section 11 of 6 *William IV.*, No. 7.

1 Section Eleven of the Act of Council of *Tasmania* of the 6 *William IV.*, No. 7, intituled "An Act to provide for the Licensing of Hawkers and Carriers," is hereby repealed, and in lieu thereof the following shall be and be deemed to be and may be cited as Section Eleven of the said Act; that is to say:—

"It shall not be lawful for any Hawker licensed under this Act to sell or offer or carry about for sale any spirits, wine, beer, or other distilled or fermented liquor; or to sell or offer for sale to any person whatever, any goods, wares, or merchandise after sunset and before sunrise. Any such Hawker who shall commit any offence against this Section shall forfeit and pay a penalty or sum of money not exceeding Twenty Pounds and not less than One Pound, and the Justice or Justices before whom any information shall be heard for any such

Hawkers not to carry about liquor, nor sell goods between sunset and sunrise.

offence is or are hereby empowered at his or their discretion to cancel the Licence of any such Hawker, and upon such cancellation such Licence shall become null and void.”

2 Section Nine of the said Act is hereby amended, by inserting after the word “Constable,” where it first occurs in the said Section, the following words; that is to say,—“or by any Justice of the Peace, or by any person authorised in that behalf by any Justice of the Peace in writing.”

Acts to be read
together.

3 This Act and the said Act shall be read and construed together as one and the same Act.
