AN ACT to appropriate certain Moneys in A.D. 1894. aid of Agricultural Settlement. [25 August, 1894.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :-

1 Out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund of the Colony of Tasmania Appropriation of there shall and may be appropriated, issued, and applied the sum of money. One Pound and Ten Shillings for every One Pound raised locally up to Four hundred Pounds, for the purpose of extending Agricultural Settlement upon such system as may be approved by the Governor in Council.

2 The Treasurer shall issue and pay the said sums to such persons Moneys payable upon such days and in such proportions as the Governor, by any by Warrant of the Warrant under his hand, from time to time, orders and directs; and Governor. the payments so to be made shall be charged upon and payable out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund for the year during which such payments shall be made.

3 The said Treasurer shall be allowed credit in his Accounts for any Credit to be given sums of money paid by him in pursuance of any such Warrant as afore- to the Treasurer said; and the receipts of the respective persons to whom the same are in Account. so paid shall be a full and valid discharge to the said Treasurer in passing his said Accounts for any such sums as are therein mentioned, and he shall receive credit for the same accordingly.
