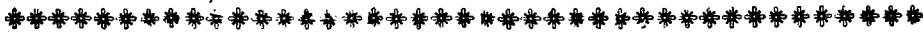

AN ACT to appropriate certain Moneys in aid of Agricultural Settlement. A.D. 1894.

[25 August, 1894.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

1 Out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund of the Colony of *Tasmania* there shall and may be appropriated, issued, and applied the sum of One Pound and Ten Shillings for every One Pound raised locally up to Four hundred Pounds, for the purpose of extending Agricultural Settlement upon such system as may be approved by the Governor in Council. Appropriation of money.

2 The Treasurer shall issue and pay the said sums to such persons upon such days and in such proportions as the Governor, by any Warrant under his hand, from time to time, orders and directs ; and the payments so to be made shall be charged upon and payable out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund for the year during which such payments shall be made. Moneys payable by Warrant of the Governor.

3 The said Treasurer shall be allowed credit in his Accounts for any sums of money paid by him in pursuance of any such Warrant as aforesaid ; and the receipts of the respective persons to whom the same are so paid shall be a full and valid discharge to the said Treasurer in passing his said Accounts for any such sums as are therein mentioned, and he shall receive credit for the same accordingly. Credit to be given to the Treasurer in Account.
