

AN ACT to appropriate certain Sums arising A.D. 1887. from the Consolidated Revenue Fund for certain Public Works for the Year commencing on the First day of July, 1887, and ending on the Thirtieth day of June, [20 December, 1887.] 1888

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :---

1 Out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund of the Colony of Tasmania there shall and may be appropriated, issued and applied, in the manner hereinafter provided, in the year commencing on the First day of July, 1887, and ending on the Thirtieth day of June, 1888, for the several purposes mentioned in the Schedule, any sum or sums of money not exceeding in amount respectively the several sums of money in the said Schedule specified.

2 The Treasurer shall issue and pay the said several sums to Moneys payable such persons for the purposes hereinbefore mentioned, upon such by Warrant of days and in such proportions as the Governor, by any Warrant under the Governor. his hand, from time to time, orders and directs; and the payments so to be made shall be charged upon and payable out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund of the said Colony.

3 The said Treasurer shall be allowed credit in his Accounts for Credit to be given any sums of money paid by him in pursuance of any such Warrant to the Treasurer as aforesaid ; and the receipts of the respective persons to whom the in Accounts.
