AN ACT to appropriate certain Sums arising A D. 1882. from the Consolidated Revenue Fund to the Service of the Colony of *Tasmania* for the Six months ending the Thirty-first day of *December*, 1882. [27 July, 1882.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :---

1 Out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund of the Colony of *Tasmania* there shall and may be appropriated, issued, and applied, for the service of the Six months ending the Thirty-first day of *December*, 1882, in the manner hereinafter provided, for the several purposes hereinafter mentioned, any sums of money not exceeding in amount respectively the several sums of money hereinafter specified; that is to say,—

Appropriation, (Consolidated Revenue Fund), 1882.

2 The Colonial Treasurer shall issue and pay the said several A.D. 1882. sums to such persons for the purposes hereinbefore mentioned, upon such days and in such proportions as the Governor, by any Warrant under his hand, from time to time, orders and directs; and the pay-the Governor. ments so to be made shall be charged upon and payable out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund.

3 The said Treasurer shall be allowed credit in his Accounts for Credit to be given any sums of money paid by him in pursuance of any such Warrant in Treasurer's as aforesaid; and the receipts of the respective persons to whom the Accounts. same are so paid shall be a full and valid discharge to the said Treasurer in passing his said Accounts for any such sums as are therein mentioned, and he shall receive credit for the same accordingly.

4 The said sums of money shall not be issued or applied to any use, Application of intent, or purpose other than those mentioned.

5 The Act of the Parliament of Tasmania of the 45th Victoria, No. Acts to be read 43, and this Act, shall for all purposes be read and construed together as together. one Act for the appropriation of the sums mentioned in the said Act and this Act to the service of the Colony of Tasmania for the Twelve months ending on the Thirty-first day of December, 1882.
