

AN ACT to appropriate certain Sums arising A.D. 1880. from the Consolidated Revenue Fund to the Service of the Colony of *Tasmania* for the Year 1880. [7 *February*, 1880.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :---

1 Out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund of the Colony of *Tasmania* there shall and may be appropriated, issued, and applied, in the manner hereinafter provided, for the several purposes hereinafter mentioned, any sums of money not exceeding in amount respectively the several sums of money hereinafter specified; that is to say,

2 The Colonial Treasurer shall issue and pay the said several Moneys payable sums to such persons for the purposes hereinbefore mentioned, upon by Warrant of the Covernor such days and in such proportions as the Governor, by any Warrant the Governor. under his hand, from time to time, orders and directs; and the pay-ments so to be made shall be charged upon and payable out of the Consolidated Persona Fund Consolidated Revenue Fund.

3 The said Treasurer shall be allowed credit in his Accounts for Credit to be given any sums of money paid by him in pursuance of any such Warrant in Treasurer's as aforesaid; and the receipts of the respective persons to whom the same are so paid shall be a full and valid discharge to the said Trea-surer in passing his said Accounts for any such sums as are therein mentioned, and he shall receive credit for the same accordingly.

4 The said sums of money shall not be issued or applied to any use, Application intent, or purpose other than those mentioned.
