### ANNO QUADRAGESIMO

AN ACT to appropriate certain Sums from the A.D. 1876. Consolidated Revenue Fund to the Service of the Colony of Tasmania for the Year 1876. [20 November, 1876.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 Out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund of the Colony of Tasmania there shall and may be appropriated, issued, and applied, in the manner hereinafter provided, for the several purposes hereinafter mentioned, any sums of money not exceeding in amount respectively the several sums of money hereinafter specified; that is to say,

For the purpose of purchasing a piece of Land at New Norfolk to be used as a Public Cemetery...... 200 As a gratuity to Mrs Horne, Widow of the late Judge Horne.

2 The Colonial Treasurer shall issue and pay the said several sums Moneys payable to such persons for the purposes hereinbefore mentioned, upon such by Warrant of days and in such proportions as the Governor, by any Warrant under the Governor. his hand, from time to time, orders and directs; and the payments so to be made shall be charged upon and payable out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund.

3 The said Treasurer shall be allowed credit in his Accounts for Credit to be given any sums of money paid by him in pursuance of any such Warrant to the Treasurer as aforesaid; and the receipts of the respective persons to whom the same are so paid shall be a full and valid discharge to the said Treasurer in passing his said Accounts for any such sums as are therein mentioned, and he shall receive credit for the same accordingly.
