# AN ACT to appropriate certain Sums of A.D. 1892. Money arising from the Consolidated Revenue Fund for the Year 1892.

[21 December, 1892.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :---

1 Out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund of the Colony of Tasmania Appropriation of for the year One thousand eight hundred and ninety-two, there shall Supplies. and may be appropriated, issued, and applied the Sum of Twelve hundred and thirty Pounds Fourteen Shillings and Ten Pence for the purposes expressed in the Schedule hereto.

2 The Treasurer shall issue and pay the several sums to such Moneys payable persons for the purposes in the said Schedule mentioned, upon such by Warrant of days and in such proportions as the Governor, by any Warrant under the Governor. his hand, from time to time, orders and directs; and the payments so to be made shall be charged upon and payable out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund for the year One thousand eight hundred and ninetytwo.

3 The said Treasurer shall be allowed credit in his Accounts for Credit to be given any sums of money paid by him in pursuance of any such Warrant as to the Treasurer aforesaid; and the receipts of the respective persons to whom the same in Account. are so paid shall be a full and valid discharge to the said Treasurer in passing his said Accounts for any such sums as are therein mentioned, and he shall receive credit for the same accordingly.
